

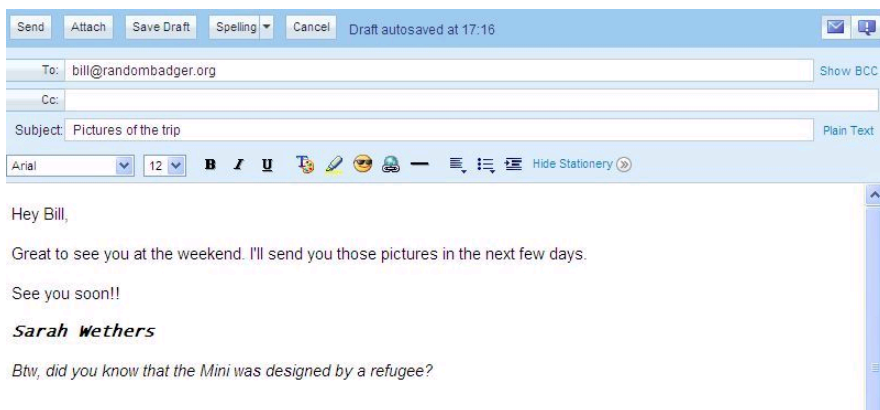
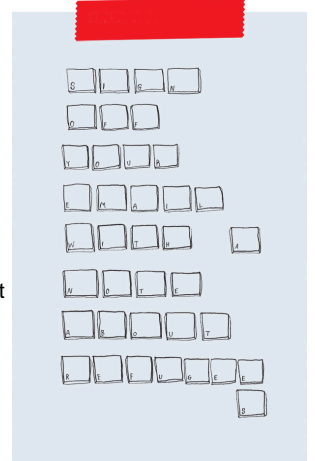
SIMPLE ACTS
